Day 1: Journey Begins to Wisconsin Dells, WI

Today is a travel day as you journey to beautiful Myrtle Beach!

Day 2: Wisconsin Dells, WI to Greensburg, IN

Arriving in Indiana this afternoon, you'll enjoy time at *Fair Oaks Farm with a guided Dairy Tour*. Explore the farms, enjoy the fresh food, and reconnect with nature, animals, and more.

Day 3: Greensburg, IN to Kodak, TN

In Clinton, TN, you'll visit *The Museum of Appalachia*. The museum is a living history museum, which is an authentic mountain farm and pioneer village that features three dozen historic log structures, several exhibit buildings filled with thousands of authentic Appalachian artifacts, multiple gardens, and free-range farm animals, all set in a picturesque venue and surrounded by split-rail fences. The building contains vast folk art collections, musical instruments, baskets, quilts, Native American artifacts, and much more. Lunch will be served here with a musical performance.

Day 4: Kodak, TN to Myrtle Beach, SC

Today, you travel through the southern countryside, arriving in Myrtle Beach, where you will spend the next four nights!

Day 5: Myrtle Beach, SC

The majority of the day is yours to enjoy at your leisure. Perhaps you want to explore the waterfront, the many shops, the Myrtle Beach Boardwalk, and the wide variety of restaurants. Later, you enjoy a *Barefoot Queen Riverboat Dinner Cruise*. North Myrtle Beach and the Grand Strand of South Carolina are rich in history and known for their beautiful waterways. It is the perfect place to enjoy beautiful views, music, cocktails, and fun.

Day 6: Myrtle Beach, SC

The morning begins with a *Saltwater Marsh Eco* tour. You'll explore Murrells Inlet and its beautiful saltwater Marsh estuary. Enjoy the tranquil waters, watch birds, and observe underwater sea life with a naturalist. There will be a live demonstration that includes local crabs. This tour also includes a 'walkabout' on a local beach so you can search for shells and other treasures. Later, at *Brookgreen Gardens*, you'll enjoy lunch and time to wander through this beautiful sculpture garden and wildlife preserve, including themed gardens with sculptures, a zoo, trails, and more. Your time at Brookgreen Garden also includes a *Huntington Sculpture Garden Tour* at Brookgreen Gardens. The day concludes at Rigatony's Theatre for a *Rigatony's Murder Mystery Dinner Show*. It's said to be 'killer' fun!

Day 7: Myrtle Beach, SC

You'll visit *Broadway at the Beach* and *Ripley's Aquarium* this morning. This sprawling outdoor entertainment includes restaurants, shopping, live shows, and more. Then, at the aquarium, immerse yourself among thousands of awe-inspiring aquatic animals, including hands-on experiences and unique animal encounters. This afternoon is a 'your choice' day. You can enjoy Captain Hook's Adventure Mini-Golf and bring back your youthful nature as you golf through this 'enchanted island' or you may decide to spend time just relaxing at the beach and resort.

Day 8: Myrtle Beach, SC

Today, you'll start your day at *Barefoot Landing*, a premier waterfront destination in South Carolina. It's home to a variety of shops, dining options, and entertainment. Next, you'll discover a hidden gem at the *Duplin Winery*. Enjoy a wine tasting complete with gourmet cheese dip and crackers. Your day continues with a visit to *Alligator Adventure* at Barefoot Landing, a unique attraction showcasing alligators with live shows and feeding sessions. The day concludes with the *Legacy Music and Memories Show* at Greg Rowles Legacy Theatre, a two-act variety show blending country, crooners, classic rock, beach music, and sing-along favorites.

Day 9: Myrtle Beach, NC to Beckley, WV

It's a travel day today as you begin your travels north.

Day 10: Beckley, WV to Dayton, OH

On your journey home, you will have a 'Mystery Stop' in the morning, followed by a visit to the *Dayton Aviation Heritage National Historical Park* in the afternoon. This historic district celebrates American aviation pioneers through exhibits and programs. The park includes the *Wright-Dunbar Interpretive Center*, which provides insight into Wilbur and Orville Wright. Additionally, you can visit *The Wright Cycle Shop*, which was the fourth bicycle shop operated by the Wrights and is the only remaining building from their bicycle business. You will also visit *Huffman Prairie Flying Field*, where the Wright brothers tested their first airplanes, along with a replica of their 1905 hangar.

Day 11: Dayton, OH to Coralville, IA

This afternoon, you'll stop at the *Peoria Zoo* in Peoria, Illinois. Explore the zoo at your leisure and enjoy wildlife from around the globe, including giraffes and rhinoceros, spider monkeys, and lions.

Day 12: Coralville, IA to Home

Arriving in Iowa this morning, visit *Matchstick Marvels*, home to dozens of wooden sculptures made exclusively of ordinary wooden matchsticks. Many of the models have historical significance, and Ripley's Believe It or Not has purchased several to be placed in museums throughout the world. Your tour concludes today.



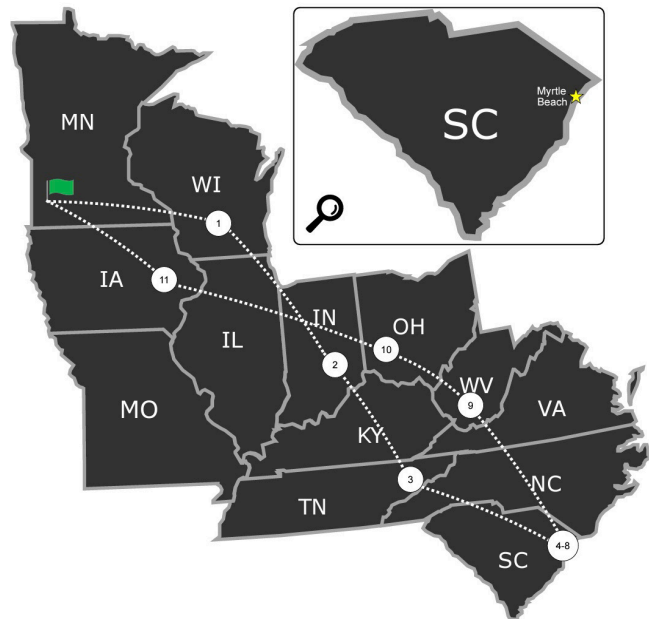
