Day 2: Twin Cities

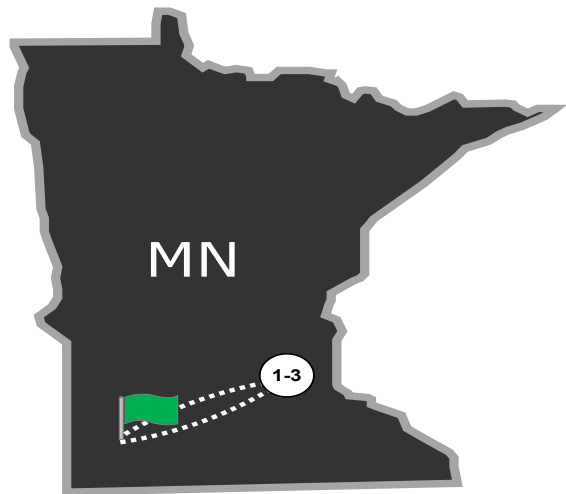
