Day 1: Journey Begins to Quincy, IL

Today is a travel day as you begin your 100-year celebration of The Grand Ole Opry tour. Our fantastic Tour Director will be sure to entertain you on your journey.

Day 2: Quincy, IL to Nashville, TN

You'll arrive in Nashville this afternoon and check into the [*Gaylord Opryland Resort & Convention Center*](#). Situated in the heart of Nashville, this resort is the city's premier aquatic attraction and features an exciting lineup of activities and entertainment. You'll find over nine acres of airy indoor garden atriums, award-winning restaurants and bars, and a world-class spa. This stunning resort is your home for the next four nights!

Day 3: Nashville, TN

Your day begins with a self-guided tour of the [*Ryman Auditorium*](#), known as the "Mother Church of Country Music." Over 130 years, this auditorium turned from a religious entity to one of the world's most well-recognized and revered music venues. You'll then tour the [*Country Music Hall of Fame & Museum*](#). Here, each attraction tells the story of popular American music through the interactive exhibits and the many artifacts on display. We'll then visit the [*Walk of Fame Park*](#), where you can stroll through a path paved with stars honoring industry legends with Nashville ties for musical contributions across all genres. You'll have free time to browse the [*Nashville Farmers Market*](#), where you will find a wide variety of local foods, crafts, classes, and chef demonstrations. Before returning to the resort, you'll tour [*Andrew Jackson's Hermitage*](#). Here, history will come alive within the walls of Andrew Jackson's magnificent home. You'll uncover the tales of this memorable figure as you wander through the rooms that witnessed his larger-than-life personality, making this an unforgettable journey into the past.

Day 4: Nashville, TN

Today begins with a guided tour of **RCA Victor Studio B**. Built in 1957, it is known as the birthplace of the “Nashville Sound.” Music titans such as Elvis Presley, Roy Orbison, the Everly Brothers, and many more recording legends. Your next two stops include museums for two more legends, the **Johnny Cash Museum**, and the **Patsy Cline Museum**. The Johnny Cash Museum has been voted the number-one music museum in the U.S., filled with hand-written notes, platinum records, costumes, and more. And while Patsy Cline was with us only until age 30, her music significantly influenced America’s country music. This museum explores her life and is filled with personal belongings, from costumes to audio recordings. You’ll participate in a candy-making class at **Goo Goo Chocolate Company** this afternoon. This total chocolate experience includes making your own candy bar and tasting some Goo Goo confections! This evening features the **General Jackson Showboat** with their all-new dinner cruise stage production featuring some of Nashville’s premiere singers, dancers, and musicians. You’ll witness vibrant choreography and costumes and hear authentic country music to make for one fantastic evening.

Day 5: Nashville, TN

Before departing the resort today, enjoy a **Delta Riverboat** ride that takes you down a scenic river that winds through the 4.5-acre indoor garden. You can admire the Delta Atrium’s natural beauty as your guide teaches facts about the plants and fish and answers questions about the resort. You are then off to a truly one-of-a-kind experience at **Belle Meade Mansion**. Here, you will have a fully guided tour through both floors of this stunning, fully-furnished 1853 Greek Revival Mansion. Your tour includes access to the grounds, outbuildings, outdoor game court, and more. In addition, a delicious 3-course lunch with complimentary wine tasting will be served in the mansion! At the **Grand Ole Opry**, enjoy an **exclusive backstage tour of the Grand Ole Opry House** and get an intimate look at the people, places, and stories behind the show that made Country Music famous. You’ll have an all-access look at the star’s dressing rooms and backstage areas and even get a chance to stand in the spotlight on the legendary Opry stage! This evening, enjoy the **Opry Country Show at the Grand Ole Opry**. You never know which country music rising star or perhaps superstar will be appearing. It will be a night to remember.

Day 6: Nashville, TN to Rock Island, IL

Today will be a travel day as you make your way home. A stay at **Bally’s Quad Cities Casino & Hotel** will give you many restaurant options, a little gaming fun, and perhaps some entertainment options.

Day 7: Rock Island, IL to Home
